1. The meeting was called to order by Chairman, Ronald Buschel;
2. Chairman Buschel requested roll call;  
**PRESENT: Fekisha Miller, Kenneth Vidrine, Glenn Stout, Jay Guidry, Jimmy Edwards, Ronald Buschel, Chairman, Leon Robinson, Ex-Officio. ABSENT: None.**  
Council Chaplin Jerry Red, Jr., led the Pledge of Allegiance and Invocation;
3. Tim Marks presented the Public Works Report with a recommendation that the Parish Code of Ordinance designate the listed intersections as three-way stop intersections:

Mr. Marks noted that due to the requirement of 750 ft. of uninterrupted road, Speed Bumps are not advised.
4. A motion was made by Glenn Stout and seconded by Kenneth Vidrine to forward to the full Council the recommendation to amend the Parish Code of Ordinance to designate the intersections of McNeese and Clover Streets, McNeese and Blue Streets, McNeese and Leday Streets, McNeese and Recard Streets and Kenneth Boagni, Sr. and Tillou Andrus Drives as three-way stop intersections.  
Mr. Marks requested that an ordinance be introduced at the next full council meeting on September 16, 2009, and a public hearing to be scheduled for October 21, 2009.

6. Mr. Ronald Buschel requested an investigation be conducted on the elevation of the curb along Hwy 105 at Pitre Road. The elevation makes it difficult for workers to make turns with trailers attached to their trucks.  
  
A motion was made by Kenneth Vidrine and seconded by Jay Guidry to forward to the full Council a request that Mr. Don Menard enter into a cooperative agreement on behalf of the parish between St. Landry Parish and Districts 5 and 6 Road Commissions to correct the curb elevation problem at Hwy 105 and Pitre Road.  
Without objection, this motion will be forwarded to the full Council.
7. Jerry Red requested an investigation at Dynasty Road near Carrington Place. The project has not been completed as planned and culverts have not been installed.

9. Mr. Merlin Fontenette of 928 Hogan Drive addressed the Public Works Committee regarding flooding on Hogan Drive.
