**PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE

1. Meeting was called to order by Chairman, Ronald Buschel;
2. Chairman Ronald Buschel requested acting Council Clerk, Mona Courville, call roll;
3. Council Chaplin Jerry Red, Jr., led the Pledge of Allegiance and Invocation;
4. The committee recommends that Tommy Mc Millan make arrangements to sell timber located on Williams & Spur roads under the direction of Tim Marks. Revenues from the sale of the timber shall be put into the parish road fund.
5. The committee recommends that surveys be sent out to constituents and service providers of Bayou Jack regarding their views on the abandonment of the Taterville Bridge.
6. The committee recommends that abandonment forms be re-sent to the property owners located on Lynn Robin Road, Arnaudville, LA. Abandonment forms sent previously had the wrong name on them.
7. The committee recommends the preliminary and final approval, be sent to the full council, of Rosewood Estates Phase 1 B with the acceptance of Critter Road, measuring One-thousand one-hundred forty-five feet (1,145'), contingent upon maintenance and surety bond being submitted by the next full council meeting. Development and roadway meet all requirements set forth in the St. Landry Parish Code of Ordinances. Developer is responsible for repairs for one (1) year, as per the surety bond and maintenance agreement.
8. The committee recommends the acceptance of Longwood Drive, measuring three thousand one hundred forty five feet (3,145') in length. The road meets all requirements and specifications set forth in the St. Landry Parish Code of Ordinances for acceptance of non-hard surface roadways. Road has passed the two (2) year maintenance period.
9. The committee recommends abandoning a portion of Thibodeaux Road beginning at a distance of one thousand four hundred thirty feet (1,430') south of Elementary Road to the end of Thibodeaux Road.
10. The committee recommends accepting the Public Works report as presented.
12. The committee recommends submitting to the full council the appointment/reappointment of board members to the Ward 3 Consolidated Gravity Drainage District No. 1 and the St. Landry Parish Tourist Commission.
13. **The committee recommends adjournment until the next Public Works Committee meeting scheduled for Monday, December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2008.**
