St. Landry Parish Animal Control wishes to thank The Humane Society of the United States and Maddie's Fund for their support to aid the parish government animal control office with grant funding to expand the facility in order to accommodate more animals. "We want to give these animals every chance available to them and any grant funding to help parish government is a much needed blessing," says Parish President Don Menard.

The parish has been awarded \$15,000 and will participate in a project called "*After Katrina: Improving the Lives of Gulf Coast Dogs & Cats*," which requires the collection of statistics on shelter counts, adoptions, intake numbers from the public, both inside and outside the parish jurisdiction and the euthanized number of animals to include if they were healthy, treatable or unhealthy. Parish President Don Menard says, "The collection of these statistics will only enhance the parishes accountability practices and give us a clearer picture of the condition and number of animals being taken in by animal control officers."

Patricia Guillory, animal control supervisor says "currently our facility can hold 38 animals and when renovations are complete the facility will hold many more. Adoptions in the parish have increased and expanding the facility will help us continue finding good homes for these animals."
